The chemical compatibility guide may be updated from time to time. If you do not find all of the specific chemicals involved in the spill on the chemical compatibility guide, **DO NOT** use GREEN STUFF® Absorbent to clean up the spill.

GREEN STUFF® Absorbent should be stored in a dry, well-ventilated area. This product is non-flammable, but will support combustion by direct contact with open flame or exposure to temperature in the range of 600° F. To extinguish a fire involving this product **prior to** it being used to absorb a chemical, use a foam, carbon dioxide or dry chemical fire extinguisher or water. At all times, avoid breathing smoke from such a fire and utilize full protective equipment, which has a self-contained breathing apparatus. To extinguish a fire involving GREEN STUFF® Absorbent after it has absorbed a chemical, the method for extinguishing must comply with acceptable methods for extinguishing a fire involving the chemical absorbed. **DO NOT** place GREEN STUFF® Absorbent in a microwave.
